### (Notes)

- It is not necessary to input for existing materials (materials which have "Node ID [material]").  
In this case, the error check function deletes the entered GADSL declaration values.
- The added column is the column that was used as Recycle mark (item 33) on Ver. 2.05 and before.
- GADSL declaration values are output into XML file.  
But, if Node ID [material] (Item 46) is entered, GADSL declaration values of the material are not output into XML file.
- The dialog for mass entry of this item to XML file added at Ver.2.20(temporary) and Ver.2.21, has been deleted because the item is added as an input item on JAMA sheet at this time.

## (Supplemental remarks)

### Data compatibilities between Old versions and Ver. 2.30

#### (1) External List

##### Not compatible

Users must use the external list Ver.2.30.

The external list of Ver. 2.21 or older can not be used because some of functions, such as material selecting function, doesn't work properly.

#### (2) CSV file

##### Compatible (Not compatible under a specified condition)

The JAMA Standard Material Datasheet can import CSV files created by older version sheet (From Ver. 2.01 to Ver. 2.21)

However some errors may occur because of the modification of materials and substances in the new external list.

In case of errors, the data has to be corrected.
